CARL MOLER PRESENTED GENERAL INFO RE: THE 2013 KIT DESIGN

Earlier this year Charlie, Mike Son, and Carl met for an hour or so and came up with some design ideas on Mike's computer... the Board met and reviewed the designs and designated one design concept to be developed further...

Principles /Philosophy

It is believed that while some change is often good... it is also believed that the motto of "if it aint broke, don't fix it" also makes a lot of sense at times as well... a number of clubs... Canyon included (in the past) have experimented with new radically different designs on almost yearly basis with often very mixed and sometimes negative outcomes... Canyon Velo now has a successful design ... the philosophy is to tweak the design but keep the brands and general color scheme in place... so... the plan for 2013 is....

Keep "continuity of design" this year...same combination of colors (Gray, Black, Blue) Keep CV "Brands" in place... CV Logos (larger on the back and revert to the logo design on the 25th anniversary jersey) , Pink Arm Band (To left arm for visibility per Sue Griesbach) and term "always remember" ...

The kit color combination will remain similar to that of the club kits since the 25th Anniversary version to maintain "jersey compatibility" within the peloton on club rides... Probably a much darker Gray base than 2012 with less contrast between the gray and black dots... the board felt that the dots are important to give "texture" to the design... also want to emphasize transitioning from lighter at the top of the jersey to very dark at the bottom to allow the jersey and shorts to blend together well... same basic design of shorts as 2012 with the different blend of the color scheme...

Sponsor Logo placement to be determined... as said the goal is to have all of our recent club jerseys be compatible on club rides... no stark differences... with the CV Logo consistent... so it is obvious that we are all on the same club...

The board also liked a couple of concepts that Mike Son put together that are a greater change from our present design but still emphasize the color scheme and logos... our goal will be to continue to develop those concepts with a possible goal of implementing such a design for 2014...
